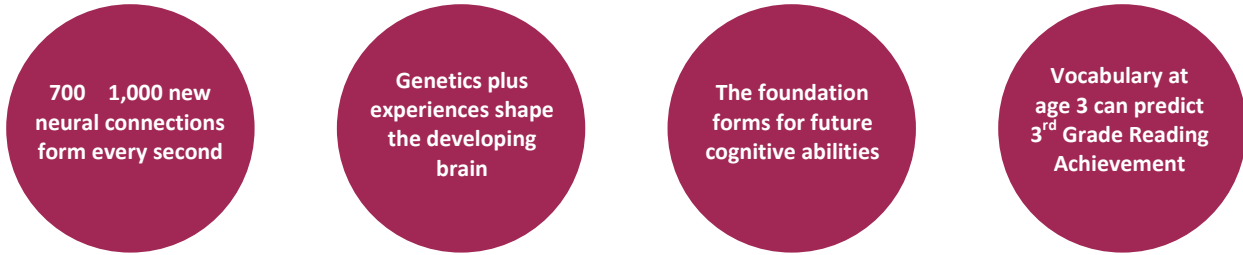

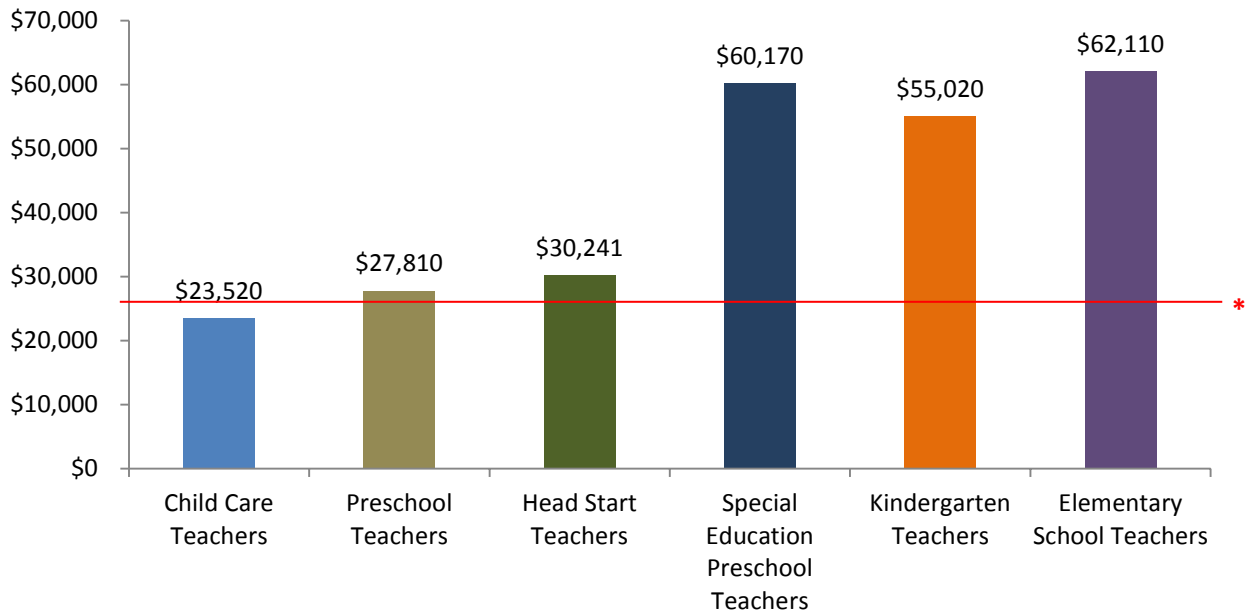
Access to High Quality Early Learning Matters!

High Quality Programs Depend on a Quality Workforce Low Wages Undermine Quality

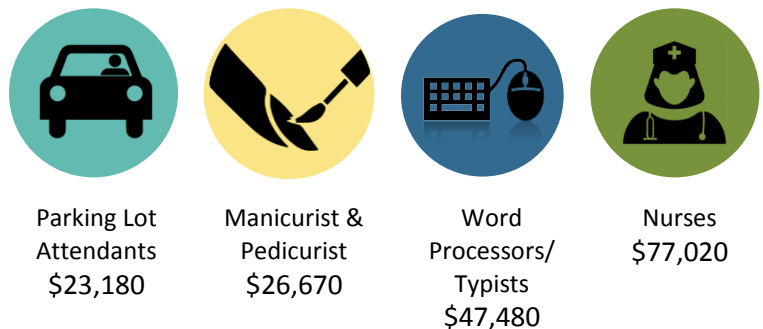
Washington Median Annual Workforce Earnings

- 535,473** Children Under Age 6

- 40.2%** Families Led by a Single Mother with Children Under Age 5 Living in Poverty
- 19.3%** Children Under Age 5 Living in Poverty
