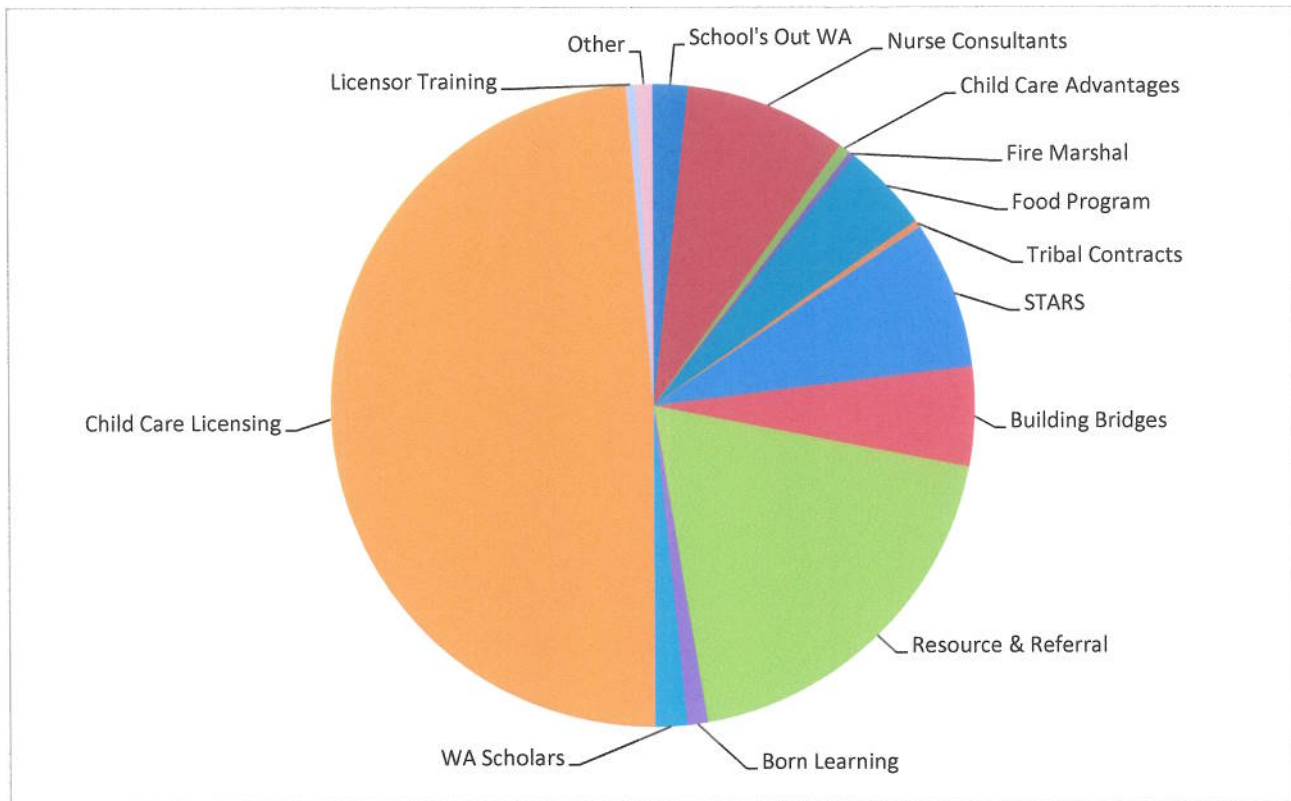

School's Out Washington	Creates a statewide community-based system for out-of-school time care for children; includes training for staff in school-age programs.	287,637	1.8%
DOH-Nurse Consultants	Offers training and consultation to child care providers to support the health, safety and development of infants and toddlers.	1,322,013	8.2%
CTED-Child Care Advantages	Provides technical assistance, grants, and loans to child care providers; promotes employer-supported child care.	91,075	0.6%
WSP-Fire Marshal	Provide fire and life safety inspections for child care centers; training and consultation for DEL licensors.	52,042	0.3%
OSPI-Food Program	Training, support and funding for family child care providers who participate in the USDA food program to support nutrition practices within their business.	708,836	4.4%
Tribal Contracts	Provides training and conference services.	59,713	0.4%
STARS System/Scholarships	Career development system to support the professional development of early learning staff.	1,193,594	7.4%
Building Bridges	Provides credit bearing provider training through technical and community colleges.	809,983	5.0%
Resource & Referral	Assists parents in locating child care services; provides training and technical assistance for parents and providers.	3,102,581	19.3%
Born Learning	Provides national Born Learning educational information to parents. Funding ended June 30, 2008.	164,367	1.0%
WA Scholars	Provides scholarships to family child care providers and center teachers.	262,500	1.6%
DEL Licensors	Licensing and monitoring of child care centers and homes.	7,845,104	48.7%
Licensors Training	Provides in-depth training to DEL Licensors.	76,550	0.5%
Other	Public awareness/consumer information and QRIS.	137,306	0.9%
